

Fern Cammy's Minyanaire of the Year remarks

I used to always say to my Dad, "I could do that & I could do that." His reply was simple. "I know you could."

I would like you to think back a few years ago to the discussion in the sanctuary about whether or not this shul should adopt an egalitarian way of functioning as a Conservative shul. There were debates back & forth for both the pro & con sides. I got up to speak against us adopting egalitarianism. Once we decided to go this route, it took me a while to accept my first Aliyah from Arthur Purdy.

As many of you recall, I would sit in the third pew from the back near the windows with my Dad. This was the best thing about Shabbat for me. When I accepted my first Aliyah, Dad looked at me and said, "Traitor, but I'm proud of you!" I remember being on the bima nervous because this was something new. Those of you who come at 9:30 on Shabbat mornings would not believe that I was ever nervous! Baby steps was all that it took.

I would always attend Shabbat services with my Dad and by myself or with Joe. It always felt good and comforting to sit in that 3rd pew. It still does. One thing led to another. Almost 3 years ago at the tender age of 91 Dad passed away. This left a tremendous void in this shul and in my life. Every Sunday Iris & I have the debate about a particular siddur & where to sit. You see, it again is about Harold Presser. I use the same siddur that he used & sit where he sat. Problem is Iris likes to use it too! We do have a deal - she gets to use it on weekdays & I get it on Sundays.

This brings us to today. I started attending Sunday morning minyan when I was saying Kaddish for Dad and never stopped. It feels good! It feels right. The camaraderie is indescribable. This is family. You are missed when you are not there. As Steve Hurok said last year when he was Minyanaire of the Year - he does it to make sure that anyone who is saying Kaddish has a minyan.

I want to paraphrase my son Shawn when we were at a shiva house a few months ago. There were plenty of people there so needing a minyan wasn't an issue. There was no one to lead the service. Next thing we knew, I was leading the service. Someone wanted to thank us. Shawn said, "It's what we do."

This is what we do! I want to thank the Men's Club from the bottom of my heart for this honor. I'm not sure how it came to be decided. What I do is simple. It's what we do.

Thank you again for this honor. I am truly touched by it and know that my parents are kvelling too!


